Currently, his breeding efforts are with Odontoglossums and Lycastes.

Scott has been involved in the AOS judging system for 28 years and is currently a Senior Judge affiliated with the Pacific Central Judging Region of the AOS. He enjoys traveling throughout California to the shows and seeing the different orchids that are grown in all the regions.

Over the years Scott has given lectures to many local societies and at several large shows and events. Some of these include the Greater New York Orchid Show in Manhattan, the World Orchid Congress in Vancouver, BC, and the Phalaenopsis Alliance Show in Los Angeles.

When not involved in orchids, Scott enjoys rambling through the deserts of California with his son rock collecting. He also spends time playing in a Bluegrass band

which has played together for 30 years.

COS Board of Directors Meeting

February 17, 2014

Board Members Present: Carol Easton, Daniel Bellam, John O'Connell, Jeanette Brown and Kathie Ritter. Club Member Present: Scott Collins

The Meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m.

The minutes of the January 13, 2014 Board Meeting were approved as written.

The Treasurer's Report for the month of January 2014 was accepted to file as was the yearend report for 2013. The Board noted the \$1,300 fund balance decline over the year and took the stance that we must close the gap with more successful fund raising.

The Vice President reported on the speaker schedule for March (Scott Collins - Lycastes) and April (John O'Connell on Building a Greenhouse – Lessons Learned) and noted that he is reducing expenditures for the Opportunity Table to \$200 (consistent with other Orchid Societies in the area).

Old Business:

The logistics for setting up the 2014 Smart Gardner Show on Saturday April 5th were worked out. Kathie will get the pop-up booth prior to the 5th and she and John and anyone else who wants to show up at 7:30 at the site will do the initial set up. Kathie and those who want to join her will buy the plants from Bay Breeze on the Thursday prior to the show. A budget of \$500 was set for plants. Members will be asked to do a member sales table.

New Business:

We have been invited to participate in the Inspired Home Expo of Monterey at the Fair Grounds on March 8th and 9th. The invitation to participate was received

between board meetings but was mentioned at the February general meeting. We will have a booth inside and will ask members with orchid plants in bloom to bring them Friday between 2:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. so that we can set up a display. Kathie will bring a small table to set up culture information, email sign-up and society literature. This will be an opportunity educate and recruit. As an enticement to join, we will offer a free plant to those who join at the show and attend the April meeting.

We have been asked if there is an interest to participate in an AOS ludging at one of our regular meetings. Scott Collins who is an AOS judge came to our Board Meeting to help us better understand what that would entail. There would be at least 3 judges present at the meeting. Members would be asked to bring in the very best blooming species plants. Judges then select out of the array before them a few, perhaps ½ dozen plants to judge. As they judge the plant, they describe the ideal plant for that specie and compare the plant to that ideal. The judges then decide if the plant is worthy of an AOS award. (To register the award a fee of \$35 is assessed.) After some discussion the Board decided to pursue an Award Meeting. John will check with Salinas and Santa Cruz clubs to see if they have an interest in participating and we will ask members about the potentially best month in which to hold the meeting.

Carol asked the Board to advise her on how to deal with new memberships taken out late in a year with respect to membership in the following year. We decided that a new membership taken out in September would be good through the following year.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:14.
