Asking The Right Questions To Be Your Own Orchid Expert

Jonathon will discuss many of the major issues facing orchid growers including: Light, Watering and water quality, Potting media, Container choice, Fertilizers, Pests & Diseases, Vetting the over-abundance of information in the internet age.

He will talk you through ways to look at your plants and with a little observation and research, figure out for yourself the best ways to grow your plants according to your individual conditions and tell which advice to listen to and which might be better ignored.

Jonathon first became interested in orchids in 1994 during a horticultural internship at the Marie Selby Botanical Gardens in Sarasota, Florida. The internship turned into a full-time job and

he worked there for several years learning about all sorts of tropical epiphytes. He went on to move around the country over the years but always had a greenhouse full of orchids. "I've grown them in hot, wet Southern Florida, the cold, wet, Pacific Northwest, and the hot, dry, California Central Valley". This has given Jonathon experience with the


